As part of Collegium's Wellness Policy (bit.ly/ccswellpol2017) and the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), all foods provided to Collegium students during school hours must comply with NSLP rules and regulations. The NSLP is a federally assisted meal program operating in public schools and other institutions. It provides nutritionally balanced, low-cost or free lunches to children each school day.
